Scholarship Guidelines & Priorities:

- Seeking graduating seniors from Watson Chapel High School.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale.
 - Official Transcripts must be provided.
- Applicants must be accepted as a fulltime student at a college, university, or trade school program.
 - Verification of enrollment from college institution must be provided.
- Scholarship funds will be paid **directly to the institution** in August of the fall semester and January of the spring semester of the student's first year.
- Each applicant must submit a typed essay, of at least 300 words.
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, school counselor, volunteer leader or church affiliate
- Applicants must submit a complete application by **March 16, 2018** late applications will not be accepted.
- The applications will be reviewed, and recipients selected by a committee consisting of volunteers.

- The scholarship will be awarded in May 2018.
